### 2. CONCESSIONAL FINANCE TO PwDs (DIVYNAGJAN)

- During the month of December, 2021, the Corporation sanctioned loan amounting to Rs. 18.52 Crore for the benefit of 3386 Persons with Disabilities (PwDs).
- During the month of December, 2021, the Corporation released loan amounting to Rs.18.46 Crore for the benefit of 3386 PwDs.
- At the end of December, 2021, book size of loans extended for the benefit of Divyangjan was Rs. 389.53 Crores.
- During the month under reference, the Corporation received Rs.33.04 Crores (Rs.32.06 Crores as Principal and Rs.0.98 Crores as interest) as repayments.

- b) <u>Job Fair</u>

A Job fair was held on 17<sup>th</sup> Dec., 2021 at VRC/NCSC for DA Campus, Karkardooma, Delhi for Persons with Disabilities (PwDs) in collaboration with Samarthanam Trust. In the said Job fair 374 PwDs attended interviews from across Delhi & NCR. 18 Employer Companies participated for recruitment and 41 Candidates were selected & 96 Candidates have been shortlisted for the next round in various domains.

Manager (Project) in the pay scale of Rs.50,000- 1,60,000/- (E-2 Level) joined the Corporation on  $30^{th}$  December, 2021.

#### c) ACTION TAKEN IN RESPONSE TO COVID-2019

During the month under reference, following measures were continued/acted upon, to fight against COVID-2019;

## I. Roster-wise Attendance

To prevent spread of COVID-19 in the Corporation, HoDs have been maintaining roster-wise attendance of employees in the office.

#### II. Employee centric measures

i) <u>Instructions issued</u>

In view of the Pandemic COVID-2019, employees of the Corporation were advised/instructed and encouraged:

- To clean hands and face frequently and not to use public transport.
- To use own/office vehicle for attending office.
- ii) Using Face masks/sanitizers, etc.

All employees were advised to wear face masks, use sanitizers on regular basis as well as avoid touching of nose/eyes by hand.
